- xv. **Document Supporting Religions Minority Status of the candidate:-**
- (a) The person belonging to Jain / Muslim / Christian minority have to produced School leaving certificate stating that Candidates belongs to Jain/ Muslim / Christian, and / or
 - (b) Certificate from Religious place that they belongs to Jain / Muslim /christian Minority
 - (c) Affidavit stating that they belong to Jain / Muslim/Christian Minority.
- xvi. **Applicant belongs to Gujrathi/Sindhi Minority:**
- (a) The person belonging to Gujrathi/Sindhi minority have to produce School leaving certificate stating that Candidate belongs to Gujrathi/Sindhi, and / or
 - (b) Affidavit stating that they belongs to Gujrathi/Sindhi Minority.
- xvii. **Applicant belongs to Hindi Linguistic Minority :**
- (a) The Candidates belonging to Hindi Linguistic minority must produce School Leaving Certificate stating that Candidates mother tongue is Hindi. In case there is no entry of mother tongue on School Leaving Certificate, he / she should bring the Certificate of Head Master / Principal of that School / Jr.College certifying that his/her mother tongue is Hindi. and
 - (b) Affidavit stating that he / she belongs to Hindi Linguistic Minority.Necessary transfer order/(s) of the parent (Rule 4.7 and Rule 4.8. and Annexure C 3(d).

8. STATE MERIT LIST

After document verification of candidates, the Competent Authority will prepare and publish the State Merit List on website of State CET Cell as per schedule.

9. DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

9.1 Selection to various health science courses at these colleges shall be subject to permission/approval/affiliation from, the (1) Govt. of India; (2) Respective Central Council (NMC/DCI/NCCIM/NCH/etc.); (3) Govt. of Maharashtra and (4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik The "intake capacity" at a particular college shall be the 'minimum number of seats' permitted by the above said authorities.

Intake capacity of all health sciences institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be available on website www.mahacet.org at later date.

9.2 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS- UNDER GOI NOMINEES AND ALL INDIA QUOTA.

9.2.1 **NOMINEES OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA:** In Government / Corporation / Government aided colleges.

A specified number of seats i.e. at the Government Medical Colleges (16 seats), Dental Colleges (3 seats) and Ayurved Colleges (5 seats) in

the Maharashtra State have been kept at the disposal of the Government of India. Seats for nominees of Government of India will be filled up by **The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi.**

9.2.2 **All India quota In Government / Corporation Medical & Dental colleges as well as in the Government, Government aided and Private BAMS, BUMS & BHMS Colleges :-** 15% seats of the intake capacity for MBBS & BDS courses at Government & Corporation Medical and Dental Colleges and 15% seats of intake capacity for BAMS, BUMS and BHMS course at Government, Government Aided and Private colleges will be filled through all India NEET UG 2021 merit. These seats will be filled by Medical counseling committee (MCC) and by the Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC) respectively. The seats surrendered from all India quota to state quota will be filled by the Commissioner, State CET CELL. The eligibility and constitutional Reservation / PWD Reservation of State quota seats will be applicable to All India Quota surrender seats.

9.2.3 **ICCR Nominated Foreign Candidates for BAMS Course under AYUSH Scholarship Scheme :** As per Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare Dept., letter No.L-20025/4/2012-IC (AYUSH), dt.10-4-2012 and Govt. of Maharashtra letter No.PGA-1012/ CR-275 /Edu-2, dt.18-10-2012, total 10 seats are kept reserved for admission to BAMS course for Foreign National candidate sponsored by Govt. of India.

9.3 **DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS TO BE ALLOTTED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY:** for In Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private Unaided / Minority colleges, after excluding the seats as provided in Para 9.2.1 and 9.2.2; the remaining seats will be at the disposal of the Competent Authority & available for candidates for Selection in the following manner.

- 9.3.1 85% seats under State quota will be made available for all the candidates from the State and these seats shall be filled on the basis of NEET Merit list. There shall be constitutional and female reservation in these seats as per prevailing Rules in this behalf.
- 9.3.2 All the seats for MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BPTH, BOTH, BASLP, BP&O & B.Sc. (Nursing) courses will be filled by the candidates from the State Merit List.
- 9.3.3 15% Institutional quota for MBBS/BDS course in Private/Minority colleges shall be filled on the All India basis which shall also include eligible NRI, OCI candidate and candidate from other State (OMS). These seats will be filled by competent authority through CAP. Such seats if remain vacant after all CAP round will be surrendered to respective institute for institutional level round. (Please refer Annxure-S dated 18.04.2017)
- 9.3.4 15% Institutional quota for other than MBBS/BDS course in Private/Minority colleges shall be filled on the All India basis which shall also include eligible NRI, OCI candidate and candidate from other State (OMS). These seats will be filled by respective institute by calling application at the respective institutions from all eligible candidates. (Please refer Annxure-S dated 13.10.2020)

9.4 DISTRIBUTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL & SPECIFIED (PARALLEL) RESERVATION SEATS:

There will be constitutional / specified reservation as per annexure B, C, D, E and F.

The candidates desirous of claiming the constitutional and / or specified reservations must have claimed the same in the online application form of NEET UG 2021 for the State of Maharashtra, failing which the claim will not be entertained subsequently.

The distribution of seats at the disposal of Competent Authority will be made, by taking into consideration the constitutional reservations and the specified reservations.

9.4.1 CONSTITUTIONAL RESERVATIONS:

The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original online application form for the State of Maharashtra. For claiming of category, Request for category claim after submission application form will not be granted. During document verification process, if constitutional category claim is found to be incorrect, same will be rectified as per the

document(s) available with the candidate. However no fresh claim for constitutional reservation i.e. from open category to reservation category will not be considered.

The Caste Certificate and the Caste/ Tribe Validity Certificate:- If a candidate claiming reservation in online application form does not submit online / produce document, then he/she will be automatically considered in open category if otherwise eligible for Open Category.

Candidates belonging to constitutional reserved category EWS must have claimed so in his online registration form of Maharashtra State quota seats, failing which such a claim will not be entertained subsequently. Candidate belonging to above **Categories (except EWS)** should produce **Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (wherever applicable)** at the time of physical document verification process. However EWS candidates must produce eligibility certificate issued by the competent Authority. Candidate who fails to produce above said certificates will be considered as **Open Category Candidate** provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of NEET-UG 2021.

The applicant request for change in category from Open to reserve once last date of online application form is over, will be straight way rejected. The candidates belonging to the backward class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate / validity at the time of document verification failing, which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidate will be treated as a general candidate. While applying online all the category candidates must mention their category as SC, ST, DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC, and EWS.

EWS reservation – 10% seats of the available seats will be reserved for EWS candidates for MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses, this reservation will be applicable only if central Government / respective council increases existing seats. For courses other than MBBS/ BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses 10% EWS reservation will be applicable on available seats (refer Annexure-T).

The Caste Validity Certificate:

- The candidates belonging to the following Backward Class categories i.e. SC, ST, DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and will be required to submit the Caste Validity Certificate at the time of physical Document Verification, failing which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidates will be treated as a general candidate.

- Candidates belonging to Backward Classes / EWS must have claimed so in his online registration form of Maharashtra State quota seats, failing which such a claim will not be entertained subsequently. Candidate belonging to above Categories (except EWS) should produce Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (wherever applicable) at the time of physical document verification process. Candidate who fails to produce above said certificates will be considered as Open Category Candidate provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of NEET-UG 2021.
 - Candidates belonging to EWS category will be required to produce Eligibility certificate for Economically Weaker Section in prescribed format of state government only (Annexure – “T”) and issued by Competent Authority, Government of Maharashtra, at the time of physical document verification process. Candidate who fails to produce above said certificates will be considered as Open Category Candidate provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of NEET-UG 2021.

Non-Creamy Layer Certificate: A candidate belonging to DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC (including SBC) and will be required to produce **non-creamy layer certificate valid up to 31/3/2022**, at the time of physical document verification and at the time of admission also, failing which claim will not be granted. It is mandatory to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCL) at the time physical document verification, candidates producing NCL after the physical document verification will be treated as open candidates.

A Candidate belonging to ‘Creamy Layer’ amongst the categories DT -A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC, SBC and must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him / her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under these categories will be required to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate as specified in the Govt. Resolutions form time to time. The certificate in prescribed Proforma stating that it is valid up to 31/3/2022 should be submitted at the time of physical document verification process.

EWS candidates should produce eligibility certificate issued by Competent Authority issued after 31/03/2021.

In all the Government, Municipal Corporation and Government aided medical Institutions constitutional reservation will be as per NEET UG 2021 Information Brochure Annexure B.

A candidate belonging to backward class from Maharashtra State only, is eligible for claiming seat under reserved category. All applications for change in category from open to reserve after the declaration of provisional merit list will be straight way rejected.

9.4.2 **Inter-se for vacant constitutional reserve seats** :- The seats remaining vacant from the categories SC, ST, DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D) & OBC will be filled from among the reserve candidates as per following groups

The groups are as follows -

GROUP - I

- (i) Scheduled Castes and Schedule Caste converted to Buddhism (S.C.)
- (ii) Scheduled Tribes including those living out-side specified area (S.T.)

GROUP - II

- (i) Vimukta Jati (DT(A))
- (ii) Nomadic Tribes (NT(B))

GROUP - III

- (i) Nomadic Tribes (NT(C))
- (ii) Nomadic Tribes(NT(D))
- (iii) Other Backward Classes (OBC) including SBC

If the seats still remain vacant then these seats will be filled by Inter-se merit from the above three combined common group of reserve candidates.,

If the seats still remain vacant then these seats will be filled by Inter-se merit among the candidate of the common state merit list.

9.4.3 **The seat(s) remaining vacant – from EWS category will allotted to general category candidates.**

9.4.4 **Children of Defence personnel (DEF): (Refer Annexure-C)**

The candidate should have claimed the Defence Category Claim in the original online application form. Request for Defence category claim after submission application form will not be granted.

The seats reserved for Defence category candidates will be filled on the basis of State merit list. In the event of non-availability of candidate in any of the defence category, the vacancies that have remained unfilled will be filled by inter-se merit of the candidates from remaining two defence categories. Minimum eligibility criteria for defence quota seats shall be as per open merit candidate for selection. As Defense quota is specified reservation seat of Defense quota will be allotted first.

9.4.5 **Person with Disability (PWD) Quota:** The candidate should have claimed the Person with Disability (PWD) quota reservation in the original Online application form. Request for PWD category claim after submission of application form will not be granted. The parallel constitutional reservation will be applied for PWD quota seats. The eligibility under PWD quota as prescribed by respective central Council from time to time will be applicable.

As per Medical Council of India, New Delhi amendment notification No: MCI-34(41)/2018-Med/170045 dated 5th Feb 2019, Five percent (5%) seats of annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with specified benchmark disabilities contained in the schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, as per **Annexure – D**. Constitutional reservation will be applied parallelly within PWD quota seats.

The specified disability categories as mentioned in the rights of persons with Disability Act 2016 are as follows.

1. Physical disability
 2. Intellectual disability
 3. Mental behavior disability
 4. Disability caused due to chronic illness
 5. Multiple disabilities
1. Candidate should mark as PWD in the online application form, failing which claim will not be granted. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate issued by certificate issuing authority in the year 2021.
 2. Such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination at any one of the under mentioned Disability Assessment Board, constituted at

The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability. The PWD certificate issue by Medical Board other than mentioned in above table will not be held valid for the purpose of admission in Health Science Course.

3. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate (issued in year 2021) in prescribed proforma (Annexure "D") from the authorities stated above. These PWD quota seats will be distributed in State level. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to respective category. For filling unfilled PWD quota seats, no fresh preference(s) will be called from the candidates. These seats will be added to the seat matrix of the state in respective category and allotted as per the preferences (choices) already exercised by the eligible candidate(s) during online preference filing system. As PWD quota is specified reservation, seats of PWD quota will be allotted first.

The candidate must satisfy other conditions of eligibility as prescribed in NEET UG 2021 brochure for selection to MBBS/BDS/BAMS etc. Courses as prescribed for respective course.

- 9.4.6 Maharashtra-Karnataka disputed border area residents (MKB) Quota: (Refer Annexure.-E)

The candidate should have claimed the MKB Quota reservation in the original online application form. Request for MKB quota claim after submission application form will not be granted.

Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection. If the seat(s) from MKB quota remains vacant, they will be filled in from Open category as they are carved out from the same category. MKB quota is specified reservation, seat of MKB quota will be allotted first.

- 9.4.7 Hilly Area (HA) Reservation:- The candidate should have claimed the Hilly area reservation in the original Online application form. Request for Hilly area reservation claim after submission application form will not be granted.

As per G.R. No.MED-1003/CR 641/03/Edu-2, dated 16/3/2004, 3% seats at Govt. / Corporation Medical colleges (MBBS course only) are reserved for the candidates from Hilly area. These seats will be distributed Uniformly at State level. There will be constitutional reservation and female reservation. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to State quota in respective category. For filling unfilled H.A. quota seats, no fresh preference(s) will be called from the candidates. These seats will be added to the seat matrix of the state quota in respective category and allotted

as per the preferences (choices) already exercised by the eligible candidate(s) during online preference filing system. Hilly area quota is specified reservation, seat of Hilly area quota will be allotted first.

(Refer Annexure.-F of NEET UG-2021 Information Brochure)

9.4.8 RESERVATION FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES:

30% seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses. This reservation shall be for all the categories like SC, ST, DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC, EWS, Common, HA, MKB & DEF and will be operated in parallel. Female Candidate will be first allotted female quota seats after exhausting female quota seat then female candidate will be allotted general seat as per merit. If requisite numbers of female candidates are not available, then these seats shall be offered to male candidates of that category.

9.4.9 CRITERIA FOR DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR MINORITY INSTITUTIONS:

All the seats at Minority College will be filled by the respective minority candidate from within the State of Maharashtra and if particular Minority candidate is not available then the remaining seats will be filled by general candidates.

9.4.10 In private unaided institution there shall be 15% institutional quota seats for MBBS/BDS course which shall be initially filled through CAP on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS. After CAP round institutional quota seats will be surrendered to institution that shall be filled by Concerned institute by calling application from candidate on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS, through Inter-se merit. The insituational quota seats for courses other than MBBS/BDS shall also be 15% of the intake capacity which shall be filled by concerned institute by calling application from eligible candidate on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS through Inter-se merit.

9.4.11 There will be 25% seats of the total intake capacity from Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions shall be reserved for constitutional reservation category candidates as notified under sub section (1) of section 5 of Maharashtra Act No XXX of 2006 Dated 01/08/2006.

9.4.12 In all private unaided institution, all the seats will be distributed uniformly at State level. There shall be 30% female reservation. There shall not be any other specified reservation.

9.4.13 Intake capacity of all health science institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be made available on website "www.mahacet.org" at later date.

9.2.2 **All India quota In Government / Corporation Medical & Dental colleges as well as in the Government, Government aided and Private BAMS, BUMS & BHMS Colleges :-** 15% seats of the intake capacity for MBBS & BDS courses at Government & Corporation Medical and Dental Colleges and 15% seats of intake capacity for BAMS, BUMS and BHMS course at Government, Government Aided and Private colleges will be filled through all India NEET UG 2020 merit. These seats will be filled by Medical counseling committee (MCC) and by the Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC) respectively. The seats surrendered from all India quota to state quota will be filled by the Commissioner, State CET CELL. The eligibility and constitutional Reservation / PWD Reservation of State quota seats will be applicable to All India Quota surrender seats.

9.3 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS TO BE ALLOTTED BY THE COMPETENT

AUTHORITY: for In Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private Unaided / Minority colleges, after excluding the seats as provided in Para 9.2.1 and 9.2.2; the remaining seats will be at the disposal of the Competent Authority & available for candidates for Selection in the following manner.

- 9.3.2.1 85% seats under State quota will be made available for all the candidates from the State and these seats shall be filled on the basis of NEET Merit list. There shall be constitutional and female reservation in these seats as per prevailing Rules in this behalf.
- 9.3.2.2 All the seats for MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BPT, BOTH, BASLP, BP&O & B.Sc. (Nursing) courses will be filled by the candidates from the State Merit List.
- 9.3.2.3 15% Institutional quota for MBBS/BDS course in Private/Minority colleges shall be filled on the All India basis which shall also include eligible NRI, OCI candidate and candidate from other State (OMS). These seats will be filled by competent authority through CAP. Such seats if remain vacant after all CAP round will be surrendered to respective institute for institutional level round. (Please refer Annexure-S dated 18.04.2017)
- 9.3.2.4 15% Institutional quota for other than MBBS/BDS course in Private/Minority colleges shall be filled on the All India basis which shall also include eligible NRI, OCI candidate and candidate from other State (OMS). These seats will be filled by respective institute by calling application at the respective institutions from all eligible candidates. (Please refer Annexure-S dated 13.10.2020)

9.4 DISTRIBUTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL & SPECIFIED (PARALLEL) RESERVATION SEATS:

There will be constitutional / specified reservation as per annexure B, C, D, E and F.

The candidates desirous of claiming the constitutional and / or specified reservations must have claimed the same in the online application form of NEET UG 2020 for the State of Maharashtra, failing which the claim will not be entertained subsequently.

The distribution of seats at the disposal of Competent Authority will be made, by taking into consideration the constitutional reservations and the specified reservations.

9.4.1 CONSTITUTIONAL RESERVATIONS:

The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original Online application form for the State of Maharashtra. For claiming of category, Request for category claim after submission application form will not be granted. The applicant request for change in category from Open to reserve once last date of online application form is over, will be straight way rejected. The candidates belonging to the backward class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate / validity at the time of document verification failing, which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidate will be treated as a general candidate. While applying online all the category candidates must mention their category as SC, ST, VJ/DT(A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC, and EWS.

EWS reservation – 10% seats of the available seats will be reserved for EWS candidates. For MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses, this reservation will be applicable only if central Government / respective council has increased / increases existing seats. For courses, other than MBBS/ BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses 10% EWS reservation will be applicable on available seats (refer Annexure-T).

The Caste Validity Certificate:

- The candidates belonging to the following Backward Class categories i.e. SC, ST, VJ/DT(A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC and will be required to submit the Caste Validity Certificate at the time of physical Document Verification, failing which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidates will be treated as a general candidate.
- Candidates belonging to Backward Classes / EWS must have claimed so in his online registration form of Maharashtra State quota seats, failing which such a claim will not be entertained subsequently. Candidate belonging to above Categories should produce Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (wherever applicable) at the time of physical document verification process. Candidate who fails to produce above said certificates will be considered as Open Category Candidate provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of NEET-UG 2020.
 - Candidates belonging to EWS category will be required to produce Eligibility certificate for Economically Weaker Section in prescribed format of state government only (Annexure – “T”) and issued by Competent Authority, Government of Maharashtra, at the time of physical document verification process. Candidate who fails to produce above said certificates will be considered as Open Category Candidate provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of NEET-UG 2020.

Non-Creamy Layer Certificate: A candidate belonging to VJ, NT1, NT2, NT3, OBC (including SBC) and will be required to produce **non-creamy layer certificate valid up to 31/3/2021**, at the time of physical document verification and at the time of admission also, failing which claim will not be granted. It is mandatory to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCL) at the time physical document verification, candidates producing NCL after the physical document verification will be treated as open candidates.

A Candidate belonging to ‘Creamy Layer’ amongst the categories (VJ) DT -A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC, SBC and must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him / her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under these categories will be required to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate as specified

in the Govt. Resolutions from time to time. The certificate in prescribed Proforma stating that it is valid up to 31/3/2021 should be submitted at the time of physical document verification process. EWS candidates should produce eligibility certificate issued by Competent Authority.

In all the Government, Municipal Corporation and Government aided medical Institutions constitutional reservation will be as per NEET UG 2020 Information Brochure Annexure B.

A candidate belonging to backward class from Maharashtra State only, is eligible for claiming seat under reserved category. All applications for change in category from open to reserve after the declaration of provisional merit list will be straight way rejected.

9.4.2 **Inter-se for vacant constitutional reserve seats** :- The seats remaining vacant from the categories SC, ST, VJ, NT1, NT2, NT3 & OBC will be filled from among the reserve candidates as per following groups

The groups are as follows -

GROUP - I

- (i) Scheduled Castes and Schedule Caste converted to Buddhism (S.C.)
- (ii) Scheduled Tribes including those living out-side specified area (S.T.)

If the seats still remain vacant then these seats will be filled by Inter-se ,merit from the above three combined common group of reserve candidates.,

If the seats still remain vacant then these seats will be filled by Inter-se merit among the candidate of the common state merit list.

9.4.3 **The seat(s) remaining vacant – from EWS category will allotted to general category candidates.**

9.4.4 **Children of Defence personnel (DEF): (Refer Annexure-C)**

The candidate should have claimed the Defence Category Claim in the original Online application form. Request for Defence category claim after submission application form will not be granted.

The seats reserved for Defence category candidates will be filled on the basis of State merit list. In the event of non-availability of candidate in any of the defence

category, the vacancies that have remained unfilled will be filled by inter-se merit of the candidates from remaining two defence categories. Minimum eligibility criteria for defence quota seats shall be as per open merit candidate for selection.

9.4.5 Person with Disability (PWD) Quota: The candidate should have claimed the Person with Disability (PWD) quota reservation in the original Online application form. Request for PWD category claim after submission of application form will not be granted. The parallel constitutional reservation will be applied for PWD quota seats.

As per Medical Council of India, New Delhi amendment notification No: MCI-34(41)/2018-Med/170045 dated 5th Feb 2019, Five percent (5%) seats of annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with specified benchmark disabilities contained in the schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, as per **Annexure – D**. Constitutional reservation will be applied parallelly within PWD quota seats.

The specified disability categories as mentioned in the rights of persons with Disability Act 2016 are as follows.

1. Physical disability
 2. Intellectual disability
 3. Mental behavior disability
 4. Disability caused due to chronic illness
 5. Multiple disabilities

The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability.

3. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate (issued in year 2020) in prescribed proforma (Annexure "D") from the authorities stated above. These PWD quota seats will be distributed in State level. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to level respective category. For filling unfilled PWD quota seats, no fresh preference(s) will be called from the candidates. These seats will be added to the seat matrix of the state level in respective category and allotted as per the preferences (choices) already exercised by the eligible candidate(s) during online preference filing system.

The candidate must satisfy other conditions of eligibility as prescribed in NEET UG 2020 brochure for selection to MBBS/BDS/BAMS etc. Courses as prescribed for respective course.

- 9.4.6 Maharashtra-Karnataka disputed border area residents (MKB) Quota: **(Refer Annexure.-E)**

The candidate should have claimed the MKB Quota reservation in the original online application form. Request for MKB quota claim after submission application form will not be granted.

Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection. If the seat(s) from MKB quota remains vacant, they will be filled in from Open category as they are carved out from the same category.

- 9.4.7 **Hilly Area (HA) Reservation:-** The candidate should have claimed the Hilly area reservation in the original Online application form. Request for Hilly area reservation claim after submission application form will not be granted.

As per G.R. No.MED-1003/CR 641/03/Edu-2, dated 16/3/2004, 3% seats at Govt. / Corporation Medical colleges (MBBS course only) are reserved for the candidates from Hilly area. **These seats will be distributed** Uniformly at State level. **There will**

be constitutional reservation and female reservation. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to State quota in respective category. For filling unfilled H.A. quota seats, no fresh preference(s) will be called from the candidates. These seats will be added to the seat matrix of the state quota in respective category and allotted as per the preferences (choices) already exercised by the eligible candidate(s) during online preference filing system.

9.4.8 RESERVATION FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES:

30% seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses. This reservation shall be for all the categories like SC, ST, VJ, NT-1, NT-2, NT-3, OBC, , EWS, Common, HA, MKB & DEF and will be operated in parallel. If requisite numbers of female candidates are not available, then these seats shall be offered to male candidates of that category.

9.4.9 CRITERIA FOR DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR MINORITY INSTITUTIONS:

All the seats at Minority College will be filled by the respective minority candidate and if particular Minority candidate is not available then the remaining seats will be filled by general candidates.

9.4.10 In private unaided institution there shall be 15% institutional quota seats for MBBS/BDS course which shall be initially filled through CAP on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS. After CAP round institutional quota seats will be surrendered to institution that shall be filled by Concerned institute by calling application from candidate on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS, through Inter-se merit. The institutional quota seats for courses other than MBBS/BDS shall also be 15% of the intake capacity which shall be filled by concerned institute by calling application from eligible candidate on All India basis including NRI/OCI/OMS through Inter-se merit.

9.4.11 There will be 25% seats of the total intake capacity from Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions shall be reserved for constitutional reservation category candidates as notified under sub section (1) of section 5 of Maharashtra Act No XXX of 2006 Dated 01/08/2006.

9.4.12 In all private unaided institution, all the seats will be distributed uniformly at State level. There shall be 30% female reservation. There shall not be any other specified reservation.

9.4.13 Intake capacity of all health science institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be made available on website "www.mahacet.org" at later date.

The seats surrendered from all India quota to state quota will be filled by the Commissioner, State CET CELL. The eligibility and constitution Reservation / PWD Reservation of State quota seats will be applicable to All India Quota surrender seats.

9.1.4 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS TO BE ALLOTTED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY: for In Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private Unaided / Minority colleges, after excluding the seats as provided in Para 9.1.2 and 9.1.3; the remaining seats will be at the disposal of the Competent Authority & available for candidates of the State for Selection in the following manner.

9.1.4.1 Out of the seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority, 5% seats for Person with disability candidates will be carved out. From the remaining seats, 30% of such seats will be made available for

candidates from the State (State 30% quota) and these seats will be filled on the basis of State Merit List. There will be constitutional, specified (except defence quota seats) and female reservations in these seats as per rules.

The online preferences filled by the candidates will be centrally processed and list of selected candidates will be declared. As per this list the candidate should join college / course allotted to him/her.

At the centre the candidates must bring along with them all the relevant documents in original and one set of attested photocopies for scrutiny.

9.1.4.1 Out of the seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority, 5% seats for Person with disability candidates will be carved out. From the remaining seats, 30% of such seats will be made available for candidates from the State (State 30% quota) and these seats will be filled on the basis of State Merit List. There will be constitutional, specified (except defence quota seats) and female reservations in these seats as per rules.

The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability.

3. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate (issued in year 2018) in prescribed proforma (Annexure "D") from the authorities stated in 9.1.5.3 (2) above at the time of verification of documents during Preference form filling process. These PWD quota seats will be distributed under 30% State quota. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to State 30% Quota. For filling these seats, no fresh preference(s) will be called from the candidates. If the marks of a candidate at HSC (or equivalent) examination have been revised on revaluation, the eligibility of the candidate may be altered. **The candidate will be permitted to avail the benefit of revised marks upto the last date of document verification, subject to his/her representation to that effect to the Competent Authority and production of necessary proof to the satisfaction of the latter.**

7. **DOCUMENT VERIFICATION:-** The Candidate will have to select any one centre for document verification, out of four centres in online registration. The four centres according to his/her online registration, where the candidate should report for document verification are given in tableno.1 bellow. The candidate should report personally (proxy not allowed) to the respective centre, as per **All India NEET UG Rank.**, mentioned as in Schedule given in Table No.2, for the Document Verification.

8. ONLINE PREFERENCE (CHOICE) FILLING PROCESS

Admission to First Year Health Science Courses for the academic year 2017-2018, will be done online by way of filling of the "Preference Form" on www.dmer.org & www.mahacet.org (Refer Annexure - P). The online preferences filled by the candidates will be centrally processed and list of selected candidates will be declared. As per this list the candidate should join college / course allotted to him/her.

At the centre the candidates must bring along with them all the relevant documents in original and one set of attested photocopies for scrutiny.

General eligibility and eligibility for constitutional reservation and specified reservation will be finalised after document verification, at the time of Document Verification and acknowledged. If the relevant documents are not produced by the candidate at the time of counselling and document verification, he/she will be declared as ineligible.

All the candidates remaining absent for document verification will not be held eligible for admission for academic year 2017-18. Their names will be permanently deleted from the Provisional Merit list.

9. DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS:

9.1 Govt. /Corporation /Govt. Aided/ Private unaided/ Minority Colleges:

- 9.1.1 Selection to various health science courses at these colleges shall be subject to permission/approval/affiliation from, the (1) Govt. of India; (2) Respective Central Council (MCI/DCI/CCIM/CCH/INC etc.); (3) Govt. of Maharashtra and (4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. The "intake capacity" at a particular college shall be the 'minimum number of seats' permitted by the above said authorities.

Intake capacity of all health sciences institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be available on website www.dmer.org & www.mahacet.org at later date.

9.1.2 NOMINEES OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA: In Government / Corporation / Government aided colleges.

A specified number of seats i.e. at the Government Medical Colleges (15 seats), Dental Colleges (3 seats) and Ayurved Colleges (5 seats) in the Maharashtra State have been kept at the disposal of the Government of India. Seats for nominees of Government of India will be filled up by **The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi.**

9.1.3 All India quota In Government / Corporation Medical & Dental colleges - 15% seats of the intake capacity for MBBS & BDS courses at Government & Corporation Medical and Dental Colleges will be filled through all India NEET UG 2017. These seats will be filled up by the ministry of Health & Family welfare, Govt. of India. The seats surrendered from all India quota will be filled by the Commissioner, State CET CELL as per direction of Central Government / State Government / Hon'ble Supreme Court from time to time. Similarly as per the Supreme Court order in Write Petition (s) (Civil) No. (s) 267/2017 dated 09/05/2017, Medical & Dental seats surrendered by DGHS at Deemed universities will be filled by Commissioner State CET CELL.

9.1.4 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS TO BE ALLOTTED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY: for In Government / Corporation / Government Aided / Private Unaided / Minority colleges, after excluding the seats as provided in Para 9.1.2 and 9.1.3; the remaining seats will be at the disposal of the Competent Authority & available for candidates of the State for Selection in the following manner.

9.1.4.1 Out of the seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority, 3% seats for Person with disability candidates will be carved out. From the remaining seats, 30% of such seats will be made available for candidates from the State (State 30% quota) and these seats will be filled on the basis of State Merit List. There will be constitutional, specified (except defence quota seats) and female reservations in these seats as per rules.

9.1.4.2 Distribution of Seats in Regional 70% Quota.

After the exclusion of State 30% quota seats mentioned at Para 9.1.4.1 the remaining 70% seats from the colleges situated in the respective Developmental Boards will be filled from amongst the Candidates who have passed HSC (or equivalent examination) from the Schools/Colleges situated in the region of the concerned Development Boards i.e. **Rest of Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada**. There will be constitutional, specified (except MKB quota seats) and female reservations for these seats as per rules.

9.4.1.3 CRITERIA FOR 70% REGIONAL QUOTA:-

- A) For candidates who have passed qualifying examination form Maharashtra State : Region of the candidates for selection under 70% regional quota will be the region from where he/she has passed 12th/HSC or equivalent examination.
- B) For candidates who have passed qualifying examination form outside the state of Maharashtra :

9.1.4.4 All the seats for BUMS, BPTH, BOTH, BASLP, BP&O & B.Sc. (Nursing) courses will be filled by the candidates from the State Level Merit List only. There will not be 70% regional quota.

9.1.5 DISTRIBUTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL & SPECIFIED (PARALLEL) RESERVATION SEATS:

The candidates desirous of claiming the constitutional and / or specified reservations must have claimed the same **in the online application form of NEET UG 2017 for the State of Maharashtra**, failing which the claim will not be entertained subsequently.

The distribution of seats at the disposal of Competent Authority will be made, by taking into consideration the constitutional reservations and the specified reservations.

9.1.5.1 **Constitutional Reservations:**

The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original Online application form for the State of Maharashtra.

The Caste Certificate and the Caste/ Tribe Validity Certificate:- No document is required to claim the reservation in online application form. Document is required only at the time of document verification process. If a candidate claiming reservation in online application form does not produce document, then he/she will be automatically considered in open category if otherwise eligible.

The applicant request for change in category from Open to reserve once provisional merit list is declared, will be straight way rejected. The candidates belonging to the backward class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate / validity at the time of document verification failing, which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidate will be treated as a general candidate. While applying online all the category candidates must mention their category as SC, ST, VJ/DT(A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC.

The Caste Validity Certificate:

- The candidates belonging to the following Backward Class categories i.e. SC, ST, VJ/DT(A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC will be required to submit the Caste Validity Certificate at the time of Document Verification, failing which the category claimed, will not be granted and the candidates will be treated as a general candidate. However, various Government resolution issued in this regard by Social Justice Department and Special Assistance / Tribal Development Department from time to time will be applicable.
- **Non-Creamy Layer Certificate:** A candidate belonging to VJ, NT1, NT2, NT3 & OBC (including SBC) will be required to produce **non-creamy layer certificate valid up to 31/3/2018**, at the time of document verification and at the time of admission also, failing which claim will not be granted. It is mandatory to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCL) at the time document verification, candidates producing NCL after the document verification will be treated as open candidates.

In all the Government, Municipal Corporation and Government aided medical Institutions constitutional reservation will be as per NEET UG 2017 Information Brochure Annexure B.

A candidate belonging to backward class from Maharashtra State only, is eligible for claiming seat under reserved category. All applications for change in category from

open to reserve after the declaration of provisional merit list will be straight way rejected.

The seats remaining vacant from the categories SC, ST, VJ, NT1, NT2, NT3 & OBC will be filled in,

- a) From among the candidates of the same category by **inter-se State merit**. If the seats still remain vacant, then the seats will be filled,
- b) From among the candidates of their **respective group of that particular Regional area** where the vacancies exist, by inter-se Regional Area merit. The groups are as follows :
 - c) i) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism (S.C)
 - ii) Scheduled Tribes (S.T)
 - d) i) Vimukta Jati - DT-A (V.J)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-B (N.T-1)
 - e) i) Nomadic Tribes - NT-C (N.T-2)
 - ii) Nomadic Tribes - NT-D (N.T-3)
 - iii) Other Backward Classes (including SBC) (O.B.C)

If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,

- f) From among the candidates of **allcategories mentioned above of that particular Regional Area** where the vacancies exist, by inter -se Regional Area merit. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- g) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the concerned Regional Area. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled,
- h) From among the candidates of the common merit list of the inter-se state merit.

9.1.5.2 Children of Defence personnel (DEF): (Refer Annx.-C)

The seats reserved for Defence category candidates will be filled regionwise. In the event of non-availability of candidate in any of the defence category, the vacancies that have remained unfilled will be filled by inter-se merit of the candidates from remaining two defence categories of the same region. Even after this, if the seats remain vacant, then they will be filled in from 70% open category as these defence seats have been carved out from 70% open category. Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection.

9.1.5.3 Person with Disability (PWD) Quota: As per Government letter No. MED-1006/CR-72/06/Edu-2, dated 07/03/2006, Three (3%) percent of the total available seats in Health Science Courses at Government, Corporation and Govt. Aided colleges are reserved for Person with disability candidates.

- 1) As per Graduate Medical Education Regulation 1997 and Amendment Notification No. MCI-34(41)/2008-Med./54469 Dated 25th March 2009, and MCI guidelines letter No.MCI-34(1)/2003-Med/11773, dated 14/07/2003 following is the criteria for reservation under PWD Category

3% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%.

Provided that in case any seat in this 3% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 3% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% - before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats of State Quota.

Provided further that this entire exercise shall be completed by each Medical institution as per the statutory time schedule for admissions and in no case any admission will be made in the Medical course after 31st of August”

- 2) The Candidate with a disability more than 70% will not be eligible for admission to Health Sciences Courses. No other disability shall be allowed as per the MCI regulations. However, such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination at any one of the under mentioned Disability Assessment Board, constituted at

i) All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Hazi Ali, Park, K. Khadya Marge, Mahalakshmi, Mumbai OR

ii) Vardhaman Mahavir Medical College & Safadarjang Hospital, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi OR

iii) Institute of Post Graduate Medical & Research, 244, Acharya J.C.Bose Marge, Kolkata OR

iv) Madras Medical College, Park Town, Chennai.

The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability.

- 3) Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate (issued in year 2017) in prescribed proforma (Annexure "D") from the authorities stated in 9.1.5.3 (2) above at the time of verification of documents during Preference form filling process.

These PWD quota seats will be distributed under 30% State quota. Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to State 30% Quota. (Refer Annexure-D of NEET UG-2017 Information Brochure). **The person with Disability candidate will have to submit Disability certificate issued by Competent Authority as mentioned above.**

The candidate must satisfy other conditions of eligibility as prescribed in NEET UG 2017 brochure for selection to MBBS/BDS/BAMS etc. Courses as prescribed for respective course.

As per notification DMER/Notification No3PH/1A dated 25/03/2012 visually handicapped candidate is eligible for admission to Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPTH) Course.

9.1.5.4 Maharashtra-Karnataka disputed border area residents (MKB) Quota: **(Refer Annexure.-E)**

Minimum eligibility criteria shall be as per open merit candidate for selection. If the seat(s) from MKB quota remains vacant, they will be filled in from 30% Open category as they are carved out from the same category.

9.1.5.5 Hilly Area (HA) Residents as per G.R. No.MED-1003/CR 641/03/Edu-2, dated 16/3/2004, 3% seats at Govt. / Corporation Medical colleges (MBBS course only) are reserved for the candidates from Hilly area. These seats will be distributed under 30% State quota, 70% Regional quota. There will be constitutional reservation and female reservation. **(Refer Annexure.-E of NEET UG-2017 Information Brochure)**

9.1.6 **RESERVATION FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES:**

30% seats at the disposal of the Competent Authority shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses. This reservation shall be for all the categories like SC, ST, VJ, NT-1, NT-2, NT-3, OBC, Common, HA, MKB & DEF. 30% female reservation shall be provided in 30% State seats & 70% regional seats of that category. If requisite numbers of female candidates are not available, then these seats shall be offered to male candidates of that category.

9.1.7 **CRITERIA FOR DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR MINORITY INSTITUTIONS:**
Government Aided / Private:

All the seats at Minority College will be filled by the respective minority candidate and if particular Minority candidate is not available then the remaining seats will be filled by general candidates.

9.1.8 The Private Institutions have 15% of total intake capacity under Institution Quota including NRI.

9.1.9 There will be 25% seats of the total intake capacity of Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions allotted to constitutional reservation category candidates.

9.1.10 In all private unaided institution, there will be 30% State and 70% Regional Quota (exception as per 9.1.4.4) from the seats available at the disposal of Competent Authority. There shall be 30% female reservation. There shall not be any other specified reservation.

9.1.11 Intake capacity of all health science institutions / courses and their seat distribution shall be made available on website "www.dmer.org" and "www.mahacet.org" at later date.
